Day 1: Overview of Common Core Math Standards (8:30-am-4pm)

This session is designed to be an introductory look at the Common Core State Standards for Mathematics (CCSSM), and is most appropriate for educators who would like to become grounded in the foundations of CCSSM. Major themes of this session are:

- What is the history and hope of the CCSSM?
- How are Common Core Standards organized – including vocabulary and structure of the document?
- What are the Standards for Mathematical Practice and how do they impact what we teach?
- Shifting Mindsets: What has to change from our current content and instruction and professional development in order to implement CCSSM well?

Day 2: Building a Foundation for Implementing Common Core Math Standards (8:30-am-4pm)

This session is a deeper look into the structure of the CCSSM, and is appropriate for participants who have either 1) been through Day 1, or 2) already have knowledge of the organization and vocabulary of the Standards and Math Practices. Major themes of this session are:

- Understanding Focus: What are the Instructional Shifts in the CCSSM at each grade level?
- Digging Deeper into the Mathematical Practices
- Connecting the Mathematical Practices to K-12 Content
