Number Playing Cards Top-It

Develops proficiency calculating within 20

Materials one deck of number playing cards paper and pencil to keep score

Number of players: 2 - 4

- 1. Determine the playing time for the game (example: 10 minutes)
- 2. Deal out all cards, face down, so that each player has a stack of cards. (ok if some players have an extra card)
- 3. Each player turns over 3 cards and determines their total. Players take turns explaining how they got their total.
- 4. Player with the highest total keeps all the cards for that round.
- 5. At the end of the designated playing time, the player with the most cards wins.

Variation:

Remove 11, 12 and 13 cards so that the game is played with the numbers 0 to 10.
