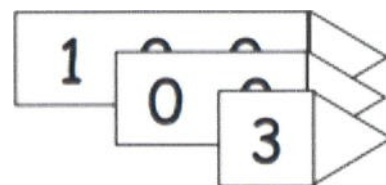
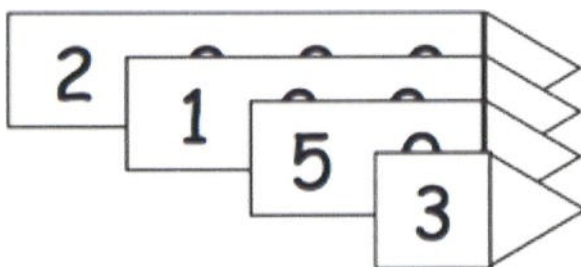


**Rules for the Arrow Cards:**

1. Arrows all point in the same direction
2. Arrows must stack on top of each other
3. Each digit must be a different color
4. Each card says its name (40 says forty, 100 says one hundred),
5. Except zero - 0 makes a lip-zip motion instead of saying its name
