

Screener Guidance for High Dosage Tutoring Teachers

Transitioning from Fall 2025 to Spring 2026

A.	Will not be tutoring during Spring 2026 ☐ Reassess your students in December using the same screener you gave them at the beginning of the semester	
	\square Record all screener data in Forefront (pre- and post-assessments)	
	\square Give your tutoring end date to your site facilitator for entry into EZreports	
В.	Will be tutoring until I "run out of hours" during Spring 2026	
	\square Reassess your students in the Spring using the same screener at the end of tutoring.	
	\square Record all screener data in Forefront (pre- and post-assessments)	
	\square Give your tutoring end date to your site facilitator for entry into EZreports	
C.	2. Splitting my total tutoring hours equally between the Fall and Spring semesters	
	☐ Reassess your students in December using the same screener you gave them at the beginning of the semester, and record in Forefront. (pre- and post-assessments)	
	☐ When you begin Spring tutoring, assess your students again using the table below to select the appropriate screeners	
	 Continue tutoring existing students that are recommended for High Dosage Tutoring, and invite new students as space allows 	

Screener Guide for HDT Assessments - Spring 2026

Student's Current Grade	Screener to Administer in Spring 2026	Overall Proficiency Score Needed to Recommend this Student for Continuation in High Dosage Tutoring
1 st	Modified 1 st Grade Midyear	7 – 20
2 nd	Modified 2 nd Grade Midyear	4 – 18
3 rd	Modified 3 rd Grade Midyear	8 – 17
4 th , 5 th and 6 th	Modified 3 rd Grade Spring	6 – 12
